

## OTHER POOLS AND LIDOS

We are thrilled to hear about many campaigns for Lidos and indoor pools and - we hope - their success in saving these pools for future generations. The original Peckham Lido, which opened in 1923, 14 years before Brockwell, measured 180 feet long and 60 feet wide, was closed in 1987 and fell derelict. After

failing to attract a buyer, it was eventually filled in with earth and became part of Peckham Rye. The proposed design includes a 50 metre heated (!) lido and a natural pool alongside. You can follow the progress of the campaign to re-create it on Facebook

We had a visit from some of the team saving <u>Newcastle City</u> <u>Pool and Turkish Baths</u>. Congratulations to them for what they have achieved in saving this wonderful asset.

On the 19th May 2015, 26 days into a 30-day <u>Kickstarter</u> <u>campaign</u>, a new outdoor swimming initiative in London reached its £125,000 crowd-funded target. The final Kickstarter total was over an amazing £142,000. The project in question was the Thames Baths.

### Here's the key info to know;

- The Thames Baths will be a floating, natural lido on the River Thames.
- It will be filled with filtered Thames water. The bespoke filtration system will ensure that the water is crystal clear.
- There will be two swimming pools, a 25m lap pool and a training pool.
- It will be warmed all year round.
- It aims to be a cultural destination with home for wildlife, a locally supplied cafe and even cine+swim nights run by popular cinema groups.
- It's nearly 80 years since Labour's Herbert Morrison called London "a city of Lidos". Thanks to people power, numbers are steadily climbing. Whether they will ever reach the numbers then (60!) is doubtful, but there is definitely a resurgence of enthusiasm and activism.

#### **GOOD NEWS!**

 Damaged floor at free weights area will be repaired this month. The edging tiles round the pool will be replaced by the end of the summer. The hydrotherapy pool is about to get a new tank.

### LCD POOL TEMPERATURE SCREEN

 A response from Luke Fenton, general manager at Brockwell Lido, to your many thoughts on the LCD SWIM SIGNS can be very confusing. Should they face the water or face away from the water? Will double-sided signs make a difference and ensure everyone is happy and swim in the direction indicated? Does anyone know why some signs indicate swimming clockwise while others are anti-clockwise? In either case, best to agree with your lane swimmers on which way to go and all stick to swimming in the same direction to avoid collision!

BROCKWELL PARK has kept its Green Flag award for another year and has also been awarded a "Bees' Needs" special award for all the work done in the park to help bees and other pollinators. A huge contribution is made by the beautiful wildflower slope behind the Lido. Thanks to all the volunteers.

PLASTIC BAGS or the lack of them in the dry side changing rooms, makes us wonder whether people should bring their own? Many already do. The wet side changing rooms have spinners, the dry side do not. Given that we are trying to be as eco-conscious as possible where we can, perhaps we should not expect Fusion to provide these.
